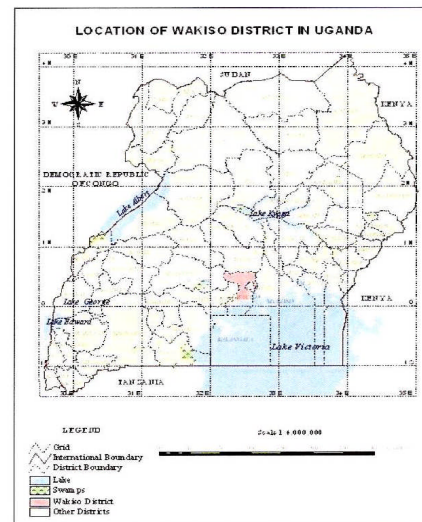


Nakuwadde Village Children

The Map of Uganda

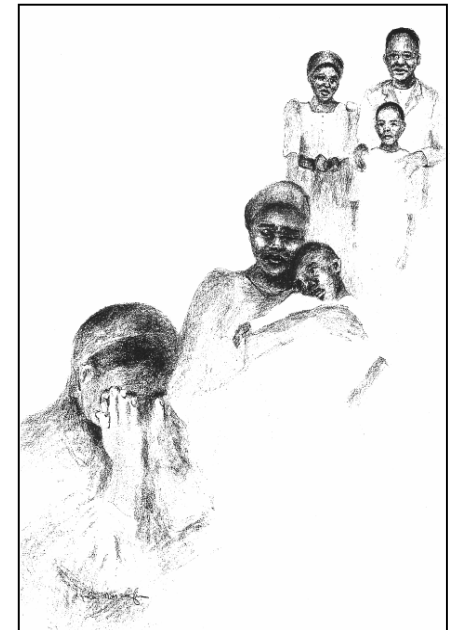


Some Statistics of Wakiso District

- One of Uganda's youngest districts, created in November 2000
- On average 500 AIDS cases per month
- Estimated prevalence rate is between 6-30%, depending on location
- 16% of deaths reported are due to AIDS
- 63% of children out of school and 41% of those in schools are orphans

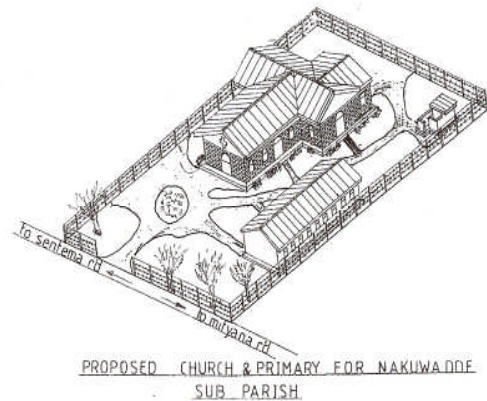
WHO WE ARE

The Ugandan American NAKUWADDE Mission Project (UANMP) is a 501(c) (3) non-profit organization based in West Hartford, Connecticut.

Our goal is to improve the health, education and economic status of the underserved population, especially women, orphans and those affected and infected with HIV/AIDS in Wakiso District, Uganda.

Our Mission

Our Mission is to fund, build and operate a multi-functional facility and deliver health care services. The facility will consist of a School (K-7), a Library, a Community Center, Community Health Center, Offices, and a Chapel.



While the Ugandan American Mission Project, Inc. will be raising funds for this very important and necessary project, the local residents of Nakuwadde will do the planning and building of the facility.

- HIV counseling and testing
- Community support for coping with HIV/AIDS
- HIV/AIDS health outreach in the home
- Nutritional support
- HIV/AIDS prevention & counseling
- Income generating projects
- Self help family programs and community support groups

Highlights & Accomplishments

- Assisted local residents of Nakuwadde and surrounding villages to organize themselves and form a local NGO in 2005.
- Conducted a needs assessment of local residents for HIV prevention, treatment and support services.
- Established relationships with senior health ministry officials.
- Identified key leaders in the community who, along with the newly formed NGO, are mobilizing the community.
- Filmed documentary of the project.
- Obtained the land and blue print for the buildings.
- Registered as a Private Volunteer Organization (PVO) with USAID.

Immediate Goal

One of the key limiting factors is the people's lack of knowledge of their HIV/AIDS status. Counseling and testing and are the key gateways to prevention and treatment.

Our immediate goal is to start HIV/AIDS counseling and testing in the home. Whether positive or negative, everyone will be linked to treatment, care, education and prevention at Kisubi Hospital, or to the national programs. The cost per person, for one year is \$180. We hope to raise the funds necessary to treat the first 200 neediest people in the district. We need your help to do this.
